- Glenda Olesen suggested Coalseam National Park for our OBT in September 2018.
- Clelia Gough advised that Lake Towerinning was also a good option.

General business

- David Hiscock enquired if Committee position hand over had been completed and asked if each member was aware of their duties. Clelia Gough suggested that the duties of each of Committee position should be listed and all filed together.
- Glenda Olesen suggested that the club look at ordering more of the warm, navy blue, fleecy
 jackets. As an option David Hiscock said that he would like to see the ordering of uniforms and
 accessories to be done on line.
- Glena Olesen showed the Committee a banner and a small flag that the Sandgroper
 Caravanners Inc. could use to display from cars and caravans. Glenda Olesen would like to see
 this once again and it would have been nice to see more of them at the State Rally.
- Laurie Tyler's partner, Patricia Ellery, has completed a membership application and paid \$40.
 Glenda Olesen does not feel that Patricia Ellery needs a separate membership. David Hiscock proposed that we refund Patricia Ellery's \$40 and we adjust our records to have Patricia Ellery as Laurie Tyler's partner. Seconded Clelia Gough
- Helen Bizzill sent David Hiscock an email and proposed that the club provide a full subsidy for the cost of the Christmas dinner this year. Ronnie Adams has agreed to coordinate Christmas dinner this year at the Brookton Rally.
- The programme for the Christmas Rally was discussed and activities agreed on. Dianne Young
 to call the Shire and complete the programme. It was agreed that gifts this year would be 1 gift
 per van, gifts should be either "usable or edible" and the purchase price should range from \$15
 to \$20.
- David Hiscock proposed that the ongoing management of the Sandgroper Caravanners website
 be carried out by a Committee member. David Hiscock said that it should be acknowledged
 that Peter Carter, the current "Webmaster" has done a great job in getting the site to where it
 is and the Club thanks him for that. Action: Club President to contact Peter Carter and advise
